NonStop RDF product status

- 9107 is **obsolete**, unsupported, and not Year 2000 compliant
- Site update tape (SUT) based (SA40, SA41, and SA42) products are **mature**
 - Supported, but not orderable
 - Only HP Storage Management Foundation (SMF) support has been added via a Software Product Revision (SPR)
 - Note: SA40 was only available on HP NonStop K-series servers
- Independent products (IPs) SA43V1 (IMP) and SA44V1 (IMPX) are **mature** on K-series
 - Supported, but not orderable

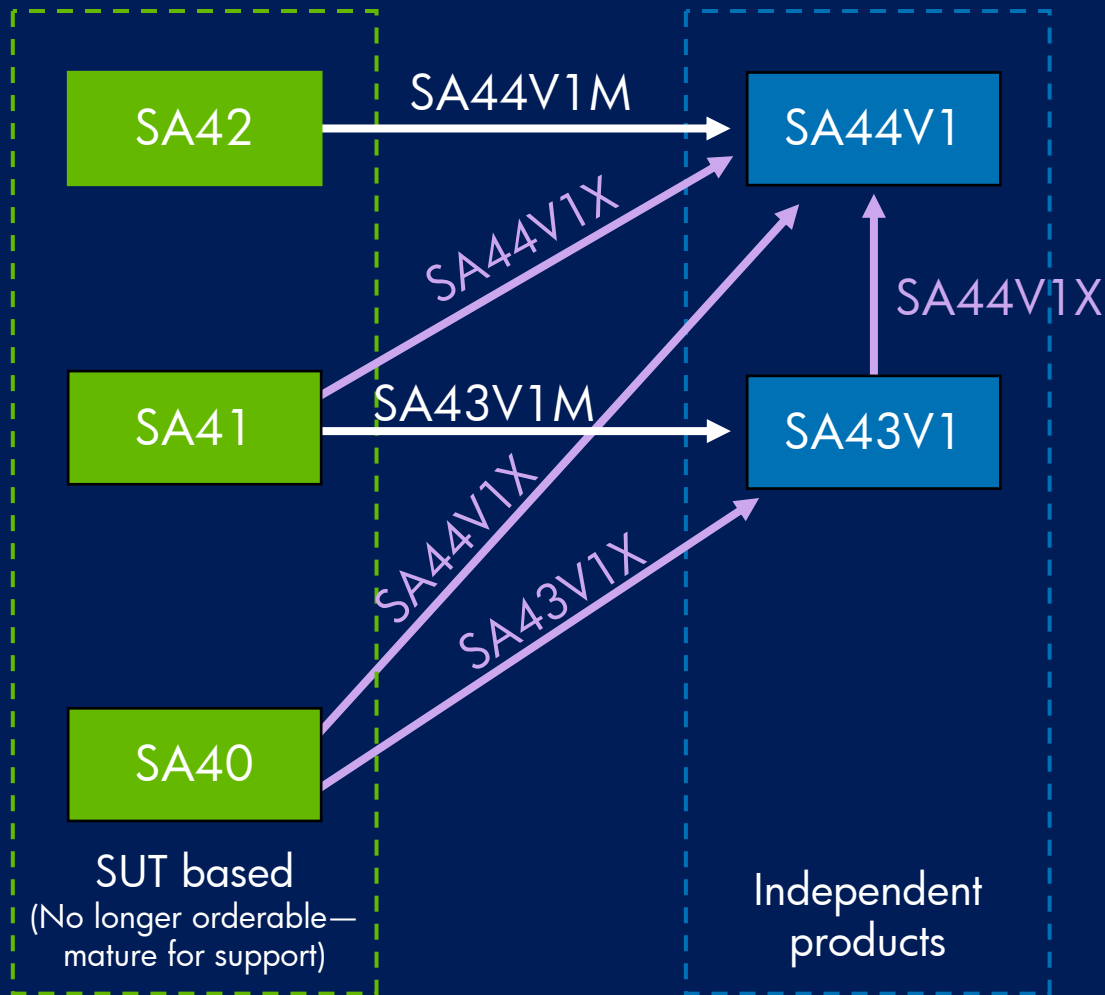
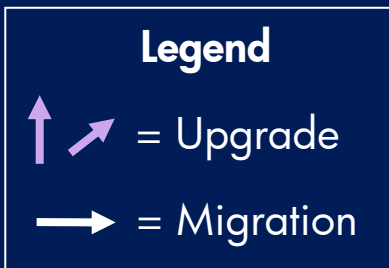
NonStop RDF product status

- IPs SA43V1 and SA44V1 are **active** on S-series
 - New features and capabilities are regularly released
- IP SA88V1 (ZLT) is available and **active** only on S-series
- IPs HSA44V1 (IMPX) and HSA88V1 (ZLT) are available and **active** only on NS-series
 - The same SPR of RDF must be used on both systems in a replication environment. i.e. RDF 1.6, 1.7, and so on.
 - For compatibility with NS-series, SA44V1 must be ordered on S-series.
 - Replication between K-series and NS-series is not supported.

NonStop RDF migration process

- Order “M” or “X” version and the new desired version
- M version: Migration is zero net one-time license charge (OLC) cost, which will
 - Cancel current license
 - Receive OLC credit for current license on the same system
- X version: Upgrade is the difference in OLC cost between the current and new version, which will
 - Cancel current license
 - Receive OLC credit for current license on the same system
